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Gene Summary:The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the family of potassium channel proteins<br/>containing two pore-forming P domains. This channel is an open rectifier which primarily<br/>passes outward current under physiological K+ concentrations, and is stimulated strongly by<br/>arachidonic acid and to a lesser degree by membrane stretching, intracellular acidification,<br/>and general anaesthetics.
