Gene Summary:LY6G6D belongs to a cluster of leukocyte antigen-6 (LY6) genes located in the major<br/>histocompatibility complex (MHC) class III region on chromosome 6. Members of the LY6<br/>superfamily typically contain 70 to 80 amino acids, including 8 to 10 cysteines. Most LY6<br/>proteins are attached to the cell surface by a glycosylphosphatidylinositol (GPI) anchor that is<br/>directly involved in signal transduction (Mallya et al., 2002 [PubMed 12079290]).[supplied by<br/>OMIM, Apr 2009]
