Gene Summary:The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the superfamily of ATP-binding cassette<br/>(ABC) transporters. ABC proteins transport various molecules across extra- and intra-cellular<br/>membranes. ABC genes are divided into seven distinct subfamilies (ABC1, MDR/TAP, MRP,<br/>ALD, OABP, GCN20, White). This protein is a member of the MRP subfamily which is involved<br/>in multi-drug resistance. This family member plays a role in cellular detoxification as a pump<br/>for its substrate, organic anions. It may also function in prostaglandin-mediated cAMP<br/>signaling in ciliogenesis.
