Gene Summary:This gene encodes a secreted high density lipoprotein which binds to apolipoprotein A-I.<br/>Apolipoprotein A-I is a relatively abundant plasma protein and is the major apoprotein of<br/>HDL. It is involved in the formation of most cholesteryl esters in plasma and also promotes<br/>efflux of cholesterol from cells. This apolipoprotein L family member may play a role in lipid<br/>exchange and transport throughout the body, as well as in reverse cholesterol transport from<br/>peripheral cells to the liver. Several different transcript variants encoding different isoforms<br/>have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Nov 2008]
