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Gene Summary:This gene belongs to the RBMY gene family which includes candidate Y chromosome<br/>spermatogenesis genes. This gene, an active X chromosome homolog of the Y chromosome<br/>RBMY gene, is widely expressed whereas the RBMY gene evolved a male-specific function in<br/>spermatogenesis. Pseudogenes of this gene, found on chromosomes 1, 4, 9, 11, and 6, were<br/>likely derived by retrotransposition from the original gene. Alternatively spliced transcript<br/>variants encoding different isoforms have been identified. A snoRNA gene (SNORD61) is<br/>found in one of its introns. [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2009]

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
