

Gene Summary:This gene encodes a leucine-rich transmembrane glycoprotein that may be involved in cell<br/>adhesion. The encoded protein is an oncofetal antigen that is specific to trophoblast cells. In<br/>adults this protein is highly expressed in many tumor cells and is associated with poor clinical<br/>outcome in numerous cancers. Alternate splicing in the 5' UTR results in multiple transcript<br/>variants that encode the same protein. [provided by RefSeq, Oct 2009]
