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Gene Summary:The protein encoded by this gene acts as a homotetramer to catalyze diacetyl reductase and<br/>L-xylulose reductase reactions. The encoded protein may play a role in the uronate cycle of<br/>glucose metabolism and in the cellular osmoregulation in the proximal renal tubules. Defects<br/>in this gene are a cause of pentosuria. Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms<br/>have been found for this gene.[provided by RefSeq, Aug 2010]

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
