






#### **Cloning Scheme:**

Cytogenetics:

### UBE2D3 (NM\_181886) Human Tagged ORF Clone - RG213585

Components: The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube

containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).

**Reconstitution Method:** 1. Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.

2. Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.

3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.

4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid

at the bottom.

5. Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of

shipping when stored at -20°C.

4q24 **Protein Pathways:** Ubiquitin mediated proteolysis

**Gene Summary:** The modification of proteins with ubiquitin is an important cellular mechanism for targeting

> abnormal or short-lived proteins for degradation. Ubiquitination involves at least three classes of enzymes: ubiquitin-activating enzymes, or E1s, ubiquitin-conjugating enzymes, or E2s, and ubiquitin-protein ligases, or E3s. This gene encodes a member of the E2 ubiquitinconjugating enzyme family. This enzyme functions in the ubiquitination of the tumorsuppressor protein p53, which is induced by an E3 ubiquitin-protein ligase. [provided by
