Our molecular clone sequence data has been matched to the sequence identifier above as a

point of reference. Note that the complete sequence of this clone is largely the same as the reference sequence but may contain minor differences, e.g., single nucleotide polymorphisms

(SNPs).

Components: The cDNA clone is shipped in a 2-D bar-coded Matrix tube as 10 ug dried plasmid DNA. The

package also includes 100 pmols of both the corresponding 5' and 3' vector primers in

separate vials.



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Note: Plasmids are not sterile. For experiments where strict sterility is required, filtration with 0.22um

filter is required.

**Summary:** This gene encodes a multifunctional protein that localizes to both the cytoplasm and nucleus.

In the cytoplasm, the encoded protein is an auxiliary component of the macromolecular aminoacyl-tRNA synthase complex. However, its mouse homolog has been shown to

translocate to the nucleus in response to DNA damage, and it plays a positive role in ATM/ATR-

mediated p53 activation. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. Read-through transcription also exists between this gene and the neighboring downstream MUTED (muted homolog) gene. An EEFIE1-related pseudogene has been identified on chromosome 2.
