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## Drebrin (DBN1) (NM\_080881) Human 3' UTR Clone - SC210168

**Components:** The cDNA clone is shipped in a 2-D bar-coded Matrix tube as 10 ug dried plasmid DNA. The

package also includes 100 pmols of both the corresponding 5' and 3' vector primers in

separate vials.

**RefSeq:** <u>NM 080881.3</u>

**Summary:** The protein encoded by this gene is a cytoplasmic actin-binding protein thought to play a role

in the process of neuronal growth. It is a member of the drebrin family of proteins that are developmentally regulated in the brain. A decrease in the amount of this protein in the brain

has been implicated as a possible contributing factor in the pathogenesis of memory

disturbance in Alzheimer's disease. At least two alternative splice variants encoding different

protein isoforms have been described for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]
