Components: The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube

containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).





#### **Reconstitution Method:**

- 1. Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.
- 2. Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.
- 3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.
- 4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid at the bottom.
- 5. Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of shipping when stored at -20°C.

**Protein Families:** Transcription Factors

**Gene Summary:** This gene encodes a member of a family of transcription factors that play a crucial role in the

control of the cell cycle. The protein encoded by this gene lacks the transactivation and tumor suppressor protein association domains found in other family members, and contains a modular suppression domain that functions in the inhibition of transcription. It interacts in a complex with chromatin modifying factors. There are pseudogenes for this gene on

chromosomes 22 and X. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided

Transcript Variant: This variant (c) contains an alternate exon and initiates translation at a downstream in-frame start codon, compared to variant a. The encoded isoform (3) has a shorter N-terminus, compared to isoform 1. Variants c, d, and e encode the same isoform (3). Sequence Note: This RefSeq record was created from transcript and genomic sequence data to make the sequence consistent with the reference genome assembly. The genomic coordinates used for the transcript record were based on transcript alignments.
