B7-1 (CD80) Mouse Monoclonal Antibody [Clone ID: MEM-233] - SM1742PP

Background: CD80 (B7-1) and CD86 (B7-2) are ligands of T cell critical costimulatory molecule CD28 and of

an inhibitory receptor CTLA-4 (CD152). The both B7 molecules are expressed on professional antigen-presenting cells and are essential for T cell activation, the both molecules can also substitute for each other in this process. The question what are the differences in CD80 and CD86 competency has not been fully elucidated yet; there are still conflicts in results about

their respective roles in initiation or sustaining of the T cell immune response.
