SP2/0 - Ag14 myeloma cell line.

Specificity: This antibody recognises the Thy1.2 cell surface antigen, and binds to T cell lines (EL-4, 3A9), T

lymphocytes and the WEH1-3 cell line. 3T3 fibroblasts are also stained by this antibody. This clone recognises a 30kD glycoprotein in Immunoprecipitation and Western blotting

assavs.

The antibody strongly induces homotypic adhesion of Thy1.2 positive cell lines.

Formulation: PBS, pH 7.4 containing 0.09% Sodium Azide as preservative.

State: Purified

State: Liquid purified IgG fraction.

Concentration: lot specific

Purification: Affinity Chromatography on Protein G.

Conjugation: Unconjugated

Storage: Store the antibody undiluted at 2-8°C for one month or (in aliquots) at -20°C for longer.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Stability: Shelf life: one year from despatch.

Background: CD90 / Thy1 antigen is a GPI linked glycoprotein member of the Immunoglobulin superfamily.

It is expressed on murine T cells, thymocytes, neural cells, cells of granulocytic lineage, early hematopoietic progenitors, fibroblasts, neurons and Kupffer's cells. Thy1 may play a role in cell to cell or cell to ligand interactions during synaptogenesis and other events in the brain. It is found in most mouse strains except AKR/J, A, Thy1.1 and B6.PL (74NS) expressing Thy1.1.
