Summary: This gene encodes a dual specificity protein kinase that phosphorylates serine/threonine and

tyrosine-containing substrates. Activity of this protein regulates serine- and arginine-rich (SR) proteins of the spliceosomal complex, thereby influencing alternative transcript splicing. Chromosomal translocations have been characterized between this locus and the PAFAH1B3

(platelet-activating factor acetylhydrolase 1b, catalytic subunit 3 (29kDa)) gene on

chromosome 19, resulting in the production of a fusion protein. Note that this gene is distinct from the TELO2 gene (GeneID:9894), which shares the CLK2 alias, but encodes a protein that

is involved in telomere length regulation. There is a pseudogene for this gene on

chromosome 7. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by

OriGene guarantees that at least two of the three Dicer-Substrate duplexes in the kit will provide at least 70% or more knockdown of the target mRNA when used at 10 nM concentration by quantitative RT-PCR when the TYE-563 fluorescent transfection control duplex (cat# SR30002) indicates that >90% of the cells have been transfected and the HPRT positive control (cat# SR30003) provides 90% knockdown efficiency.
