| Summary:            | This gene encodes a secreted high density lipoprotein which binds to apolipoprotein A-I.<br>Apolipoprotein A-I is a relatively abundant plasma protein and is the major apoprotein of<br>HDL. It is involved in the formation of most cholesteryl esters in plasma and also promotes<br>efflux of cholesterol from cells. This apolipoprotein L family member may play a role in lipid<br>exchange and transport throughout the body, as well as in reverse cholesterol transport from<br>peripheral cells to the liver. Several different transcript variants encoding different isoforms<br>have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Nov 2008] |
