**Summary:** This gene encodes an N-acetylglucosamine 6-O sulfotransferase. The encoded enzyme

transfers sulfate from 3'phosphoadenosine 5'phospho-sulfate to the 6-hydroxyl group of Nacetylglucosamine on glycoproteins. This protein is localized to the Golgi and is involved in the modification of glycan structures on ligands of the lymphocyte homing receptor L-

selectin. Alternate splicing in the 5' UTR results in multiple transcript variants that encode the

OriGene guarantees that at least two of the three Dicer-Substrate duplexes in the kit will provide at least 70% or more knockdown of the target mRNA when used at 10 nM concentration by quantitative RT-PCR when the TYE-563 fluorescent transfection control duplex (cat# SR30002) indicates that >90% of the cells have been transfected and the HPRT positive control (cat# SR30003) provides 90% knockdown efficiency.
