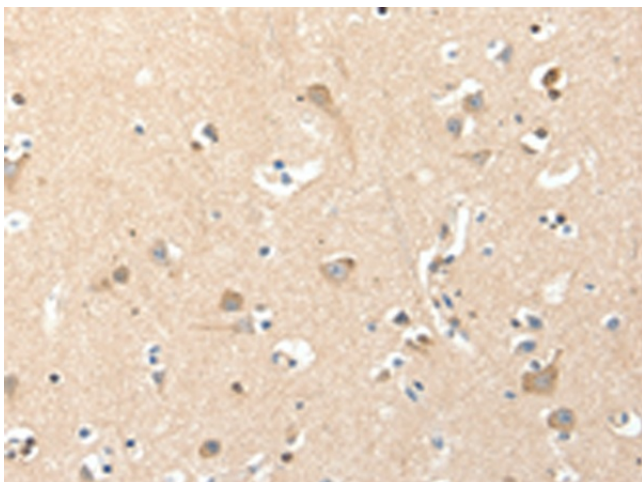

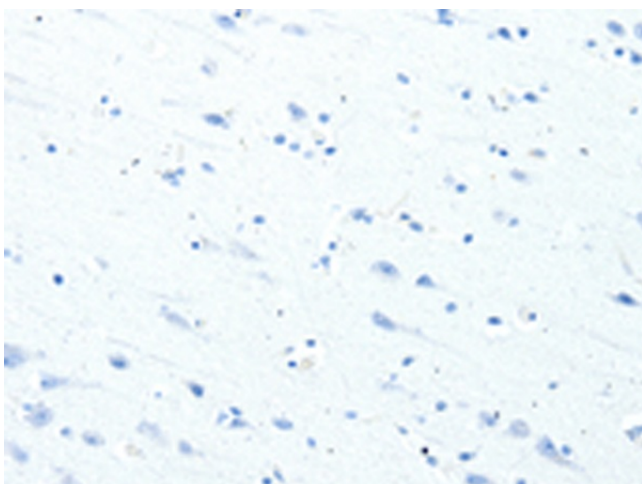

Background:	The protein may be important in cardiac antiarrhythmia via the strong suppression of voltage-gated L-type Ca ²⁺ currents. As regulator of voltage-dependent L-type calcium channel subunit alpha-1C trafficking to the cell membrane. Inhibits cardiac hypertrophy through the calmodulin-dependent kinase II (CaMKII) pathway and phosphorylation and activation of CAMK2D. Mostly expressed in the heart and muscle of type II diabetic humans. Also found in the skeletal muscle; lung and adipose tissue. Lesser amounts in placenta and kidney.

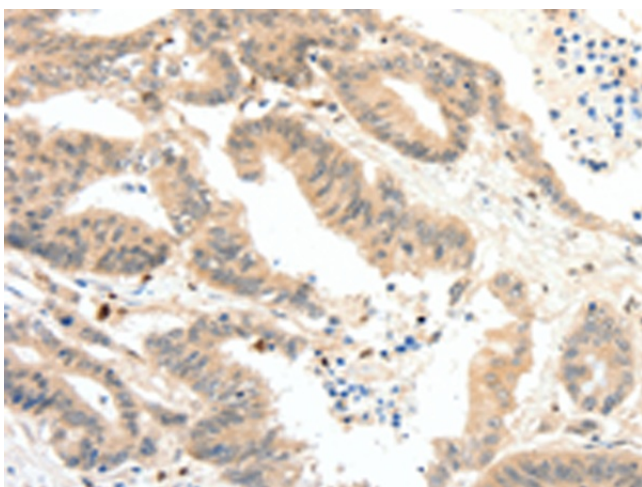

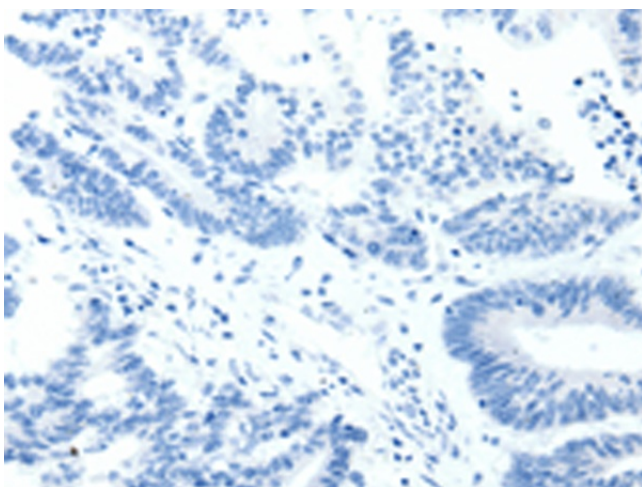
