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
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




NRAS Antibody (C-term) (Cat. #TA324983) western blot analysis in MCF-7 cell line lysates (35ug/lane). This demonstrates the NRAS antibody detected the NRAS protein (arrow).



Formalin-fixed and paraffin-embedded human lung carcinoma tissue reacted with NRAS antibody (C-term), which was peroxidase-conjugated to the secondary antibody, followed by DAB staining. This data demonstrates the use of this antibody for immunohistochemistry; clinical relevance has not been evaluated.





NRAS Antibody (C-term) (Cat. #TA324983) flow cytometric analysis of NCI-H460 cells (right histogram) compared to a negative control cell (left histogram).FITC-conjugated goat-anti-rabbit secondary antibodies were used for the analysis.
