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Background: H1FOO may play a key role in the control of gene expression during oogenesis and early


embryogenesis, presumably through the perturbation of chromatin structure. H1FOO is essential for meiotic maturation of germinal vesicle-stage oocytes. The somatic type linker histone H1c is rapidly replaced by H1oo in a donor nucleus transplanted into an oocyte. The greater mobility of H1oo as compared to H1c may contribute to this rapid replacement and increased instability of the embryonic chromatin structure. The rapid replacement of H1c

with H100 may play an important role in nuclear remodeling.
