Background:GAL3ST3 is a member of the galactose-3-O-sulfotransferase protein family. It catalyzes<br/>sulfonation by transferring a sulfate group to the 3' position of galactose in N-<br/>acetyllactosamine in both type 2 (Gal-beta-1-4GlcNAc-R) oligosaccharides and core-2-<br/>branched O-glycans, but not on type 1 or core-1-branched structures. This gene, which has<br/>also been referred to as GAL3ST2, is different from the GAL3ST2 gene located on<br/>chromosome 2 that encodes a related enzyme with distinct tissue distribution and substrate<br/>specificities, compared to galactose-3-O-sulfotransferase 3.This gene encodes a member of<br/>the galactose-3-O-sulfotransferase protein family. 
