
The ZNF91 gene encodes a zinc finger protein of the KRAB (Kruppel-associated box) subfamily (Bellefroid et al., 1991, 1993 [PubMed 2023909] [PubMed 8467795]). [supplied by OMIM, May 2010]. Transcript Variant: This variant (1) represents the longer transcript and encodes the longer isoform (1).
