Formulation:	Neat undiluted antiserum, lyophilized, packaged under nitrogen. Reconstitute by adding 50µl distilled water. This will give the equivalent of undiluted antiserum.

Storage:	Original vial: at least one year at 4° - 8°C from date of delivery. Minimize repeated thawing and freezing of the antiserum by freezing aliquots at -20°C or below.

Background:	Prepro-ANF (26-55) is one of four peptide hormones derived from the atrial natriuretic prohormone. It is also known as long acting natriuretic peptide and it has potent vasodilatory properties. Prepro-ANF (26-55) is present in higher concentration in individuals with congestive heart failure and causes the increase in prostaglandin E2 (PGE2) levels of the three peptides. This antibody was generated by immunization of rabbits with Prepro-Atrial Natriuretic Factor (26-55) coupled to a carrier protein.
