**Formulation:** This polyclonal antibody is supplied as a lyophilized powder. The powder should be

rehydrated with 50ml of RIA buffer. Upon reconstitution to 50ml total volume, the solution contains 0.1M sodium phosphate buffer (pH 7.4), 0.05M NaCl, 0.1% BSA, 0.01% NaN3, and 0.1% Triton X-100. Store at  $4^{\circ}$  -  $8^{\circ}$ C. This should ensure antibody stability for approximately

one month.

**Conjugation:** Unconjugated

Storage: Original vial: at least one year at 4° - 8°C from date of delivery. Minimize repeated thawing

and freezing of the antiserum by freezing aliquots at -20°C or below.

**Background:** Secretin is a gastrointestinal peptide hormone that regulates secretions in the stomach,

pancreas, and liver. It is produced from the enterochromaffin cells in the duodenum in response to a duodenal content with a pH below 4.5. Secretin is also involved in body fluid homeostasis and is considered a neuropeptide hormone since it is also expressed in the central nervous system. This antibody was generated by immunization of rabbits with

Secretin coupled to a carrier protein.
