Formulation: Each vial contains enough antiserum for 500 RIA tubes. The powder should be rehydrated

> with 50ml RIA buffer. Upon reconstitution to 50ml total volume, the solution contains 0.1M sodium phosphate buffer (pH 7.4), 0.05M NaCl, 0.1% BSA, 0.01% NaN3, and 0.1% Triton X-100. Store at 4°C. This should ensure antibody stability for approximately one month.

Background: Oxyntomodulin (OXM) a 37-amino acid peptide hormone found in the colon, produced by the

> oxyntic cells of the oxyntic mucosa. It is known to suppress appetite and causes weight loss in humans and rodents. Oxyntomodulin activates both the glucagon-like peptide-1 receptor (GLP1R) and the glucagon receptor (GCGR). It contains the same sequence as Glucagon (1-29), but with an additional KRNKNNIA C-terminal sequence. This antibody was generated by

immunization of rabbits with Oxyntomodulin coupled to a carrier protein.
