Recommended Dilution: Sandwich ELISA: To detect hIL-12 by sandwich ELISA (using 100 ul/well antibody solution) a

concentration of 0.5 - 2.0 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with ProSci's Biotinylated Anti-Human IL-12 as a detection antibody,

allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hIL-12.

Western Blot

To detect hIL-12 by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1-0.2 ug/ml. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hIL-12 is 1.5-3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

Background: IL-12 is a potent regulator of cell-mediated immune responses and it induces IFN-gamma

production by NK and T cells. It is produced by activated monocytes/macrophage cells, B lymphocytes and connective tissue-type mast cells. Among its biological activities, IL-12 promotes the growth and activity of activated NK, CD4+ and CD8+ cells, and induces the development of IFN-gamma-producing Th1 cells. Recombinant Human IL-12 is a 75.0 kDa heterodimeric glycoprotein consisting of disulfide-linked 35 kDa (p35) and 40 kDa (p40)

subunits (503 total amino acid residues).
