Reconstitution Method: Restore with deionized water (or equivalent) - Reconstitution Volume: 2.0 mL

Concentration: lot specific

Conjugation: HRP

Storage: Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -

20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as

an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

Note: Suitable for immunomicroscopy and flow cytometry or FACS analysis as well as other

antibody based fluorescent assays requiring extremely low background levels, absence of F(c) mediated binding, lot-to-lot consistency, high titer and specificity. The maximum amount of reagent required to stain 1 x 10E6 cells in flow cytometry is approximately 1.0 μ g of antibody. Lesser amounts of reagent may be sufficient for staining. Optimal titers for other applications should be determined by the researcher. As a general guideline dilutions of 1:100 to 1:250

should be suitable for most applications.
