undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. Freezing alkaline phosphatase

conjugates will result in a substantial loss of enzymatic activity.


Note: Anti-Rat IgG Alkaline Phosphatase antibody has been tested by ELISA and is suitable for use

in ELISA, immunohistochemistry, and western blot. Specific conditions for reactivity should be

optimized by the end user.

Western Blot of Anti-Rat IgG (H&L) (GOAT) Antibody (Min X Human Serum Proteins) (p/n 612-1125). Lane M: 3 µl Molecular Ladder. Lane 1: Rat IgG whole molecule (p/n 012-0102). Lane 2: Rat IgG F(c) Fragment (p/n 012-0103). Lane 3: Rat IgG Fab Fragment (p/n 012-0105). Lane 4: Rat IgM Whole Molecule (p/n 012-0107). Lane 5: Rat Serum (p/n [D310-05]). All samples were reduced. Load: 50 ng per lane. Block: MB-070 for 30 min at RT. Primary Antibody: Anti-Rat IgG (H&L) (GOAT) Antibody (Min X Human Serum Proteins) (p/n 612-1125) 1:1,000 for 60 min at RT. Secondary Antibody: Anti-Goat IgG (DONKEY) Peroxidase Conjugated Antibody (p/n CUST10) 1:40,000 in MB-070 for 30 min at RT. Predicted/Obsevered Size: 25 and 55 kDa for Rat IgG and Serum, 25 kDa for F(c) and Fab, 78 and 25 kDa for IgM. Rat F(c) migrates slightly higher.
