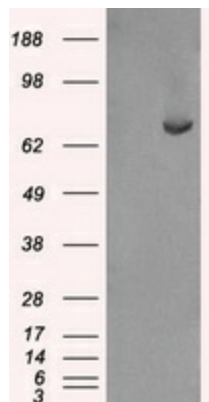

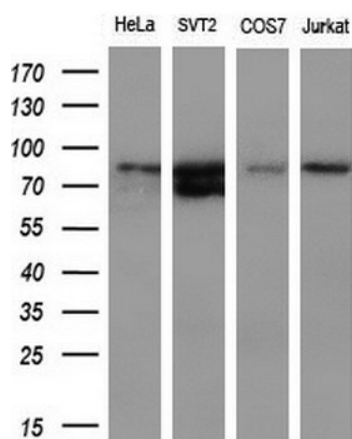

Background:	Participates in the connection between ECM adhesion sites and the actin cytoskeleton and also in the orchestration of actin assembly and cell shape modulation. Recruits migfilin (FBLP1) protein to cell-ECM focal adhesion sites.

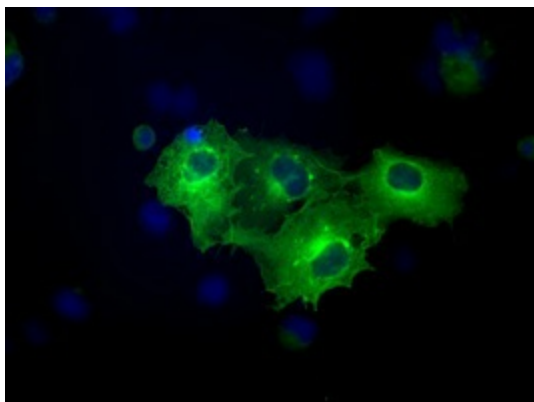

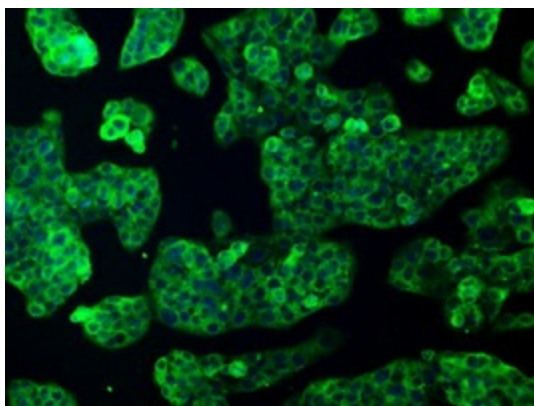
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY FERMT2 ([RC205727], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-FERMT2. Positive lysates [LY416377] (100ug) and [LC416377] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



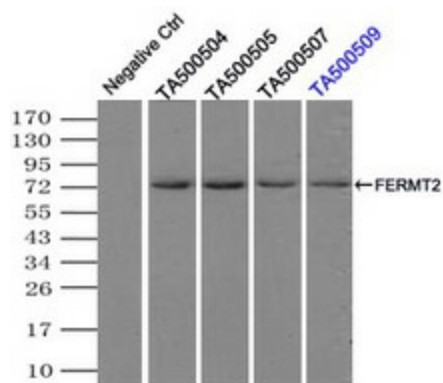
Western blot analysis of extracts (10ug) from 4 different cell lines by using anti-FERMT2 monoclonal antibody (1:200).



Anti-FERMT2 mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA500509]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY FERMT2 ([RC205727]).



Immunofluorescent staining of HeLa cells using anti-FERMT2 mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA500509]).



Immunoprecipitation of FERMT2 by using TrueMab monoclonal anti-FERMT2 antibodies (Negative control: IP without adding anti-FERMT2 antibody.). For each experiment, 500ul of DDK tagged FERMT2 overexpression lysates (at 1:5 dilution with HEK293T lysate), 2ug of anti-FERMT2 antibody and 20ul (0.1mg) of goat anti-mouse conjugated magnetic beads were mixed and incubated overnight. After extensive wash to remove any non-specific binding, the immunoprecipitated products were analyzed with rabbit anti-DDK polyclonal antibody.
