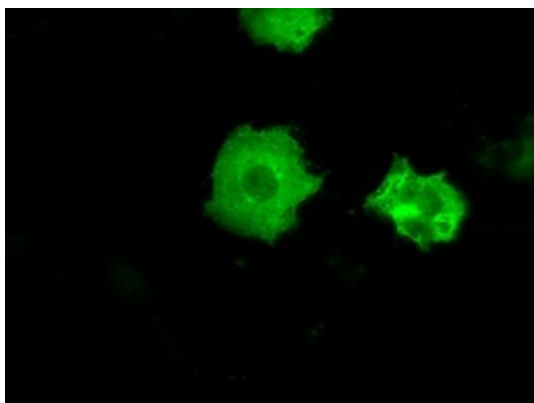

Background:	This gene is similar to the protein kinase, X-linked gene in the pseudoautosomal region of the X chromosome. The gene is classified as a transcribed pseudogene because it has lost a coding exon that results in all transcripts being candidates for nonsense-mediated decay (NMD) and unlikely to express a protein. Abnormal recombination between this gene and a related gene on chromosome X is a frequent cause of XX males and XY females.


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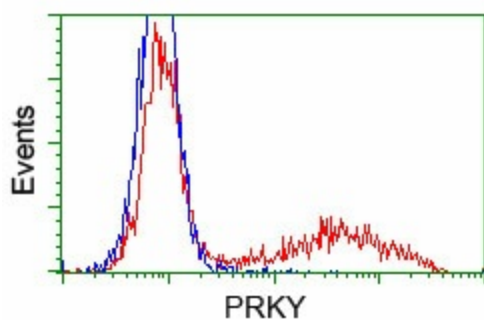

Anti-PRKY mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA500563]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY PRKY ([RC210438]).



HEK293T cells transfected with either pCMV6-ENTRY PRKY ([RC210438]) (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained with anti-PRKY mouse monoclonal ([TA500563], Dilution 1:1,000), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
