Background:	The protein encoded by this gene is involved in the efficient repair of DNA single-strand breaks formed by exposure to ionizing radiation and alkylating agents. This protein interacts with DNA ligase III, polymerase beta and poly (ADP-ribose) polymerase to participate in the base excision repair pathway. It may play a role in DNA processing during meiogenesis and recombination in germ cells. A rare microsatellite polymorphism in this gene is associated with cancer in patients of varying radiosensitivity. [provided by RefSeq]

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





HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY XRCC1 ([RC204952], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-XRCC1 (1:1000).




Western blot analysis of extracts (10ug) from 4 different cell lines by using anti-XRCC1 monoclonal antibody at 1:200 dilution.


