Background: Has a omega-amidase activity. The role of omega-amidase is to remove potentially toxic

intermediates by converting alpha-ketoglutaramate and alpha-ketosuccinamate to biologically useful alpha-ketoglutarate and oxaloacetate, respectively. Overexpression decreases the colony-forming capacity of cultured cells by arresting cells in the G2 phase of











HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY NIT2 ([RC210660], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-NIT2. Positive lysates [LY402761] (100ug) and [LC402761] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.

Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (10 ug per lane) of wild-type 293T cells (WT, Cat# LC810293T) and NIT2-Knockout 293T cells (KO, Cat# [LC812235]) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-NIT2 monoclonal antibody [TA501081], (1:100). Then the blotted membrane was stripped and reprobed with anti-HSP90AB1 antibody ([TA500494]) as a loading control.






