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
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
Background:This gene encodes a member of the cytochrome P450 superfamily of enzymes. The
cytochrome P450 proteins are monooxygenases which catalyze many reactions involved in
drug metabolism and synthesis of cholesterol, steroids and other lipids. However, this
protein is considered a member of the cytochrome P450 superfamily on the basis of
sequence similarity rather than functional similarity. This endoplasmic reticulum membrane
protein catalyzes the conversion of prostglandin H2 to thromboxane A2, a potent
vasoconstrictor and inducer of platelet aggregation. The enzyme plays a role in several
pathophysiological processes including hemostasis, cardiovascular disease, and stroke.
Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this




HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY TBXAS1 ([RC208028], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-TBXAS1. Positive lysates [LY420741] (100ug) and [LC420741] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.





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

Anti-TBXAS1 mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA501380]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY TBXAS1 ([RC208028]).

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HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC208028] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-TBXAS1 antibody ([TA501380]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
