









HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MIOX ([RC210070], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MIOX. Positive lysates [LY413679] (100ug) and [LC413679] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Anti-MIOX mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA501454]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY MIOX ([RC210070]).



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC210070] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-MIOX antibody ([TA501454]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.



Flow cytometric Analysis of Jurkat cells, using anti-MIOX antibody ([TA501454]), (Red), compared to a nonspecific negative control antibody (TA50011), (Blue).
