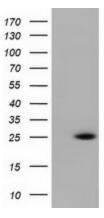

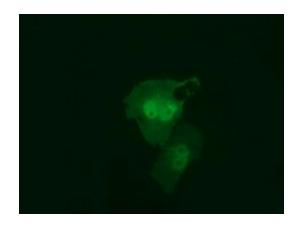




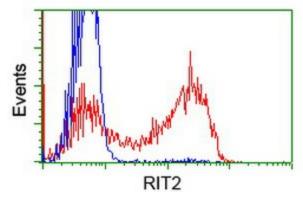
# **Product images:**



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY RIT2 ([RC205367], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-RIT2. Positive lysates [LY401022] (100ug) and [LC401022] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Anti-RIT2 mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA501703]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY RIT2 ([RC205367]).



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC205367] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-RIT2 antibody ([TA501703]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
