Background:

Histone acetylation and deacetylation, catalyzed by multisubunit complexes, play a key role in the regulation of eukaryotic gene expression. The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the histone deacetylase/acuc/apha family and is a component of the histone deacetylase complex. It also interacts with retinoblastoma tumor-suppressor protein and this complex is a key element in the control of cell proliferation and differentiation. Together with metastasis-associated protein-2, it deacetylates p53 and modulates its effect on cell growth and apoptosis. [provided by RefSeq]








HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY HDAC1 ([RC201745], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-HDAC1. Positive lysates [LY417624] (100ug) and [LC417624] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.




Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-HDAC1 monoclonal antibody.





Anti-HDAC1 mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA502142]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY HDAC1 ([RC201745]).



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC201745] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-HDAC1 antibody ([TA502142]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
