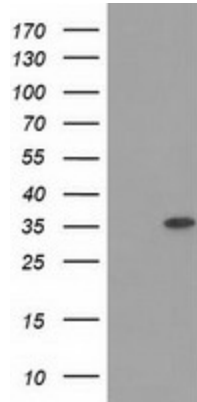

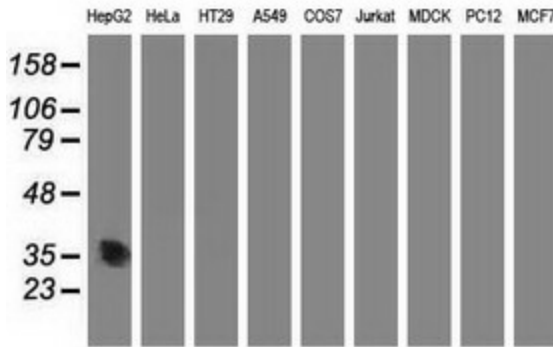

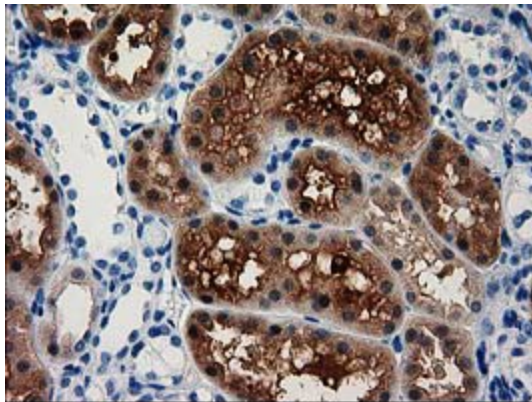

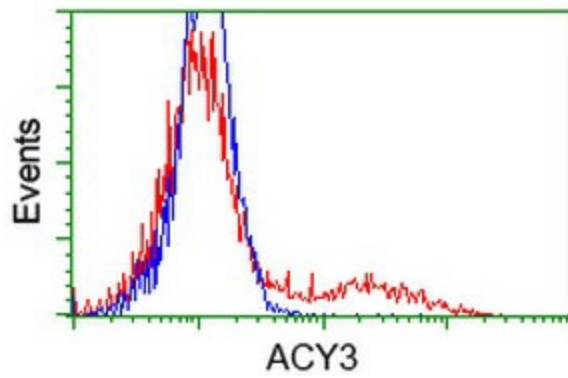
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY ACY3 ([RC202287], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-ACY3. Positive lysates [LY408962] (100ug) and [LC408962] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-ACY3 monoclonal antibody (HepG2: human; HeLa: human; SVT2: mouse; A549: human; COS7: monkey; Jurkat: human; MDCK: canine; PC12: rat; MCF7: human).



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffin-embedded Human Kidney tissue within the normal limits using anti-ACY3 mouse monoclonal antibody. (Heat-induced epitope retrieval by 10mM citric buffer, pH6.0, 100°C for 10min, [TA502297])



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC202287] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-ACY3 antibody ([TA502297]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
