Background: This gene encodes a member of the short-chain nonmetalloenzyme alcohol dehydrogenase

protein family. The encoded enzyme is responsible for the metabolism of prostaglandins, which function in a variety of physiologic and cellular processes such as inflammation. Mutations in this gene result in primary autosomal recessive hypertrophic osteoarthropathy and cranioosteoarthropathy. Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have






Figure A, Western blot analysis of overexpressed lysates(15ug per lane) from HEK293T cells transfected with empty plasmid ([PS100001], NC), human HPGD plasmid ([RC204160], hHPGD), mouse HPGD plasmid ([MR203530], mHPGD) using anti-HPGD antibody [TA502450](1:500). Figure B, Western blot analysis of the same samples as figure A with anti-DDK antibody ([TA180144], 1:1000)



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffinembedded Adenocarcinoma of Human endometrium tissue using anti-HPGD mouse monoclonal antibody. (Heat-induced epitope retrieval by 10mM citric buffer, pH6.0, 100°C for 10min, [TA502450])



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC204160] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-HPGD antibody ([TA502450]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
