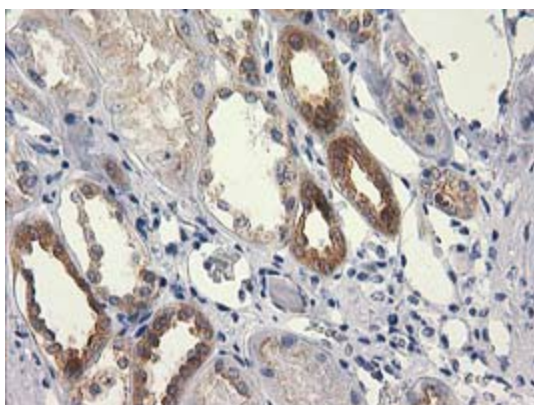

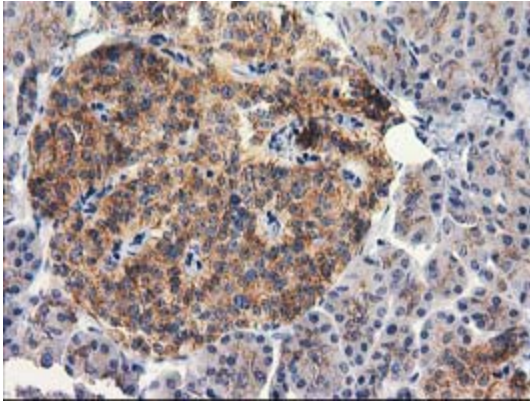
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY RTN4IP1 (Cat# [RC202957], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-RTN4IP1 (Cat# [TA502544]). Positive lysates [LY409966] (100ug) and [LC409966] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



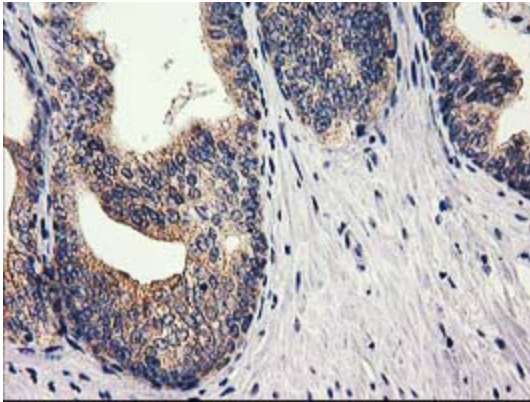

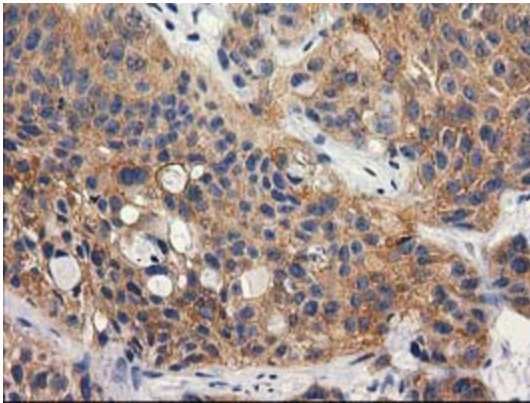

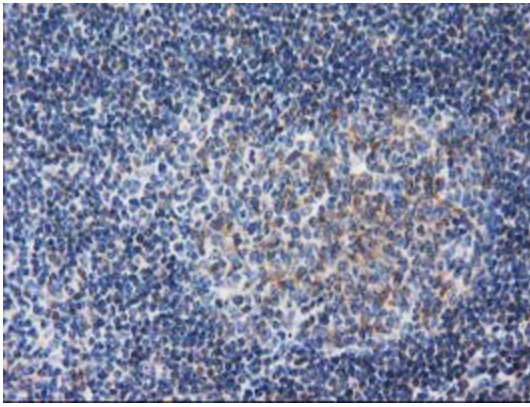

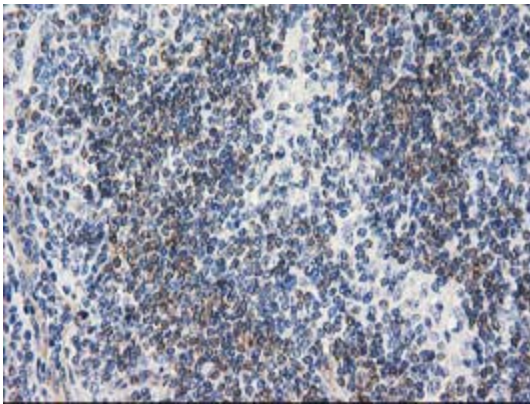

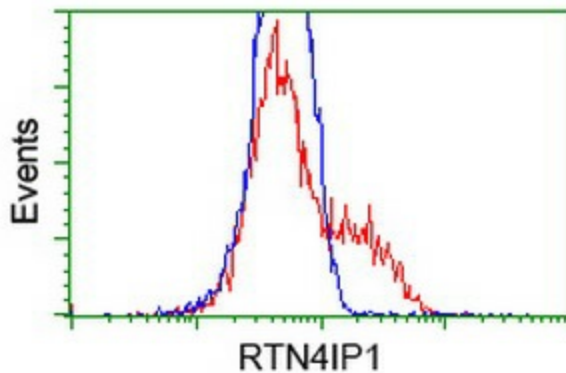

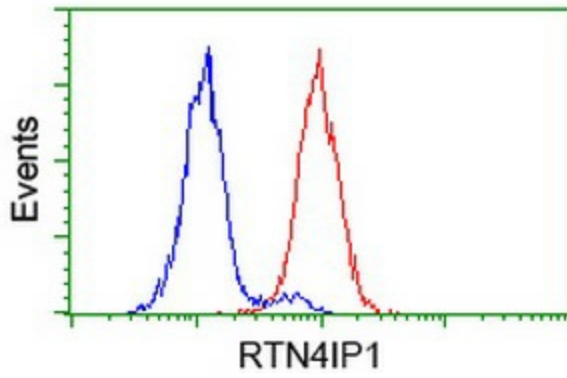

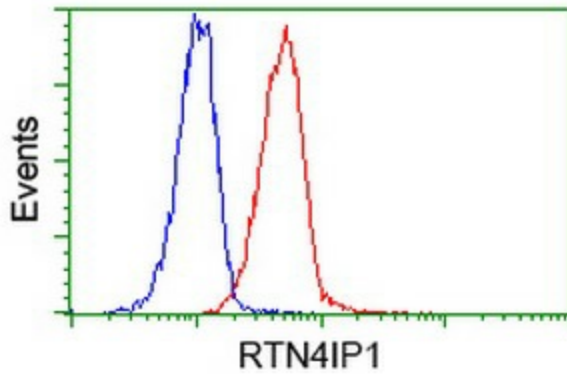
