Background:	The protein encoded by this gene phosphorylates vitamin B6, a step required for the conversion of vitamin B6 to pyridoxal-5-phosphate, an important cofactor in intermediary metabolism. The encoded protein is cytoplasmic and probably acts as a homodimer. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been described, but their biological validity has not been determined. 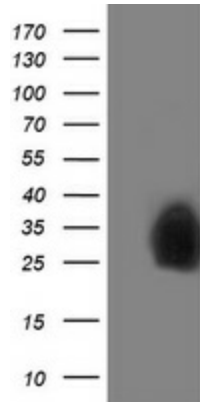


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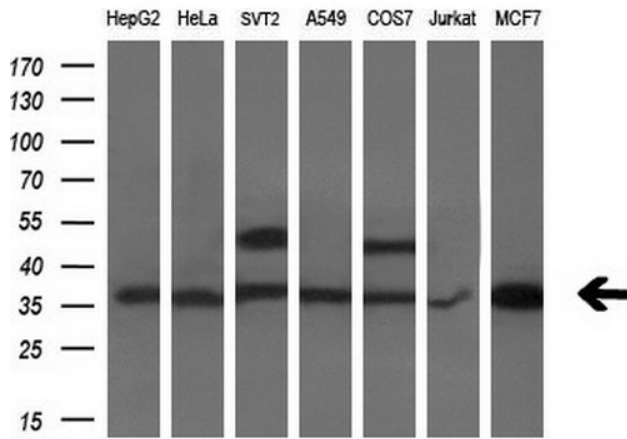

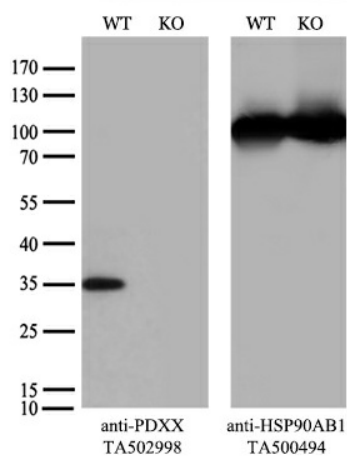

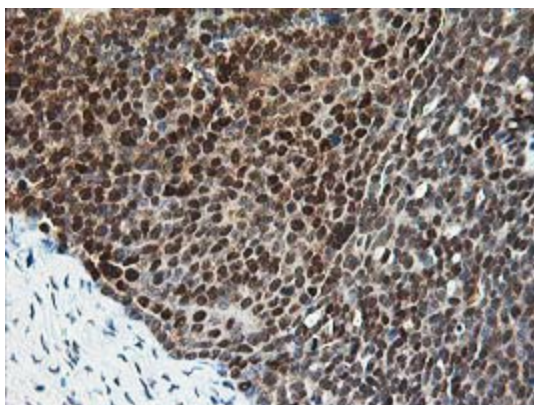
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY PDXK (Cat# [RC200975], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-PDXK(Cat# [TA502998]). Positive lysates [LY418499] (100ug) and [LC418499] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



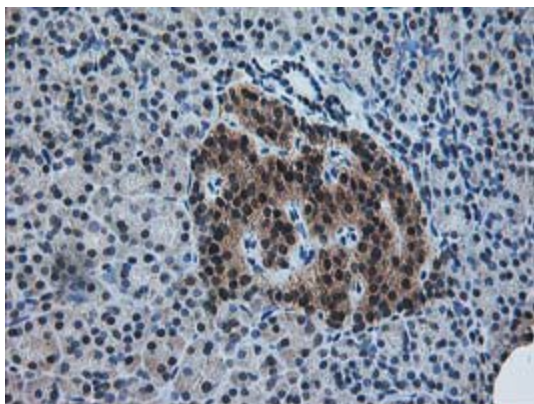
Western blot analysis of extracts (10ug) from 7 different cell lines by using anti-PDXK monoclonal antibody (1:200).



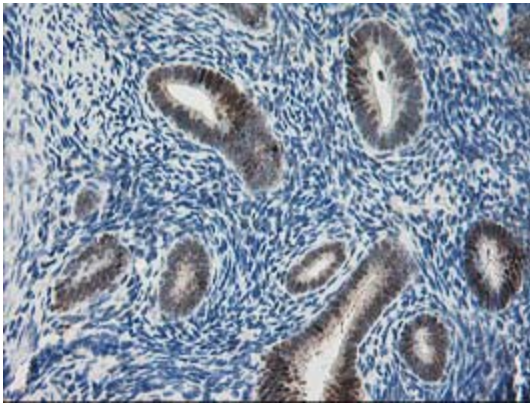
Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (10 ug per lane) of wild-type HEK293T cells (WT, Cat# LC810293T) and PDXK-Knockout HEK293T cells (KO, Cat# [LC841087]) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-PDXK monoclonal antibody [TA502998] (1:500). Then the blotted membrane was stripped and reprobed with anti-HSP90 antibody as a loading control.



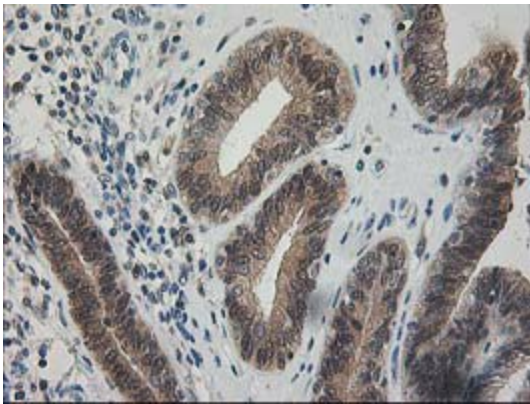

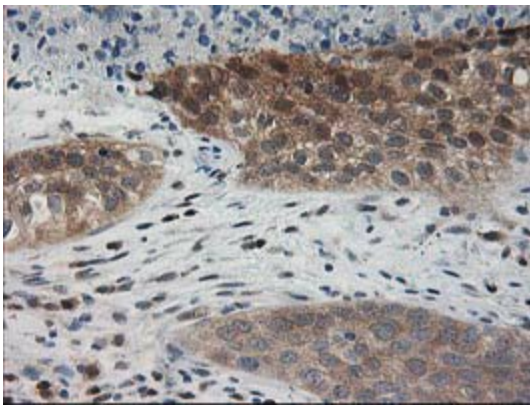

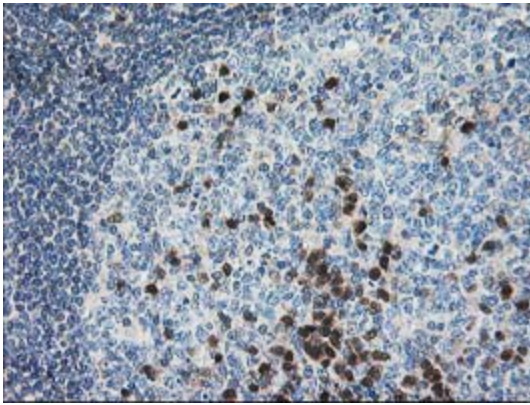

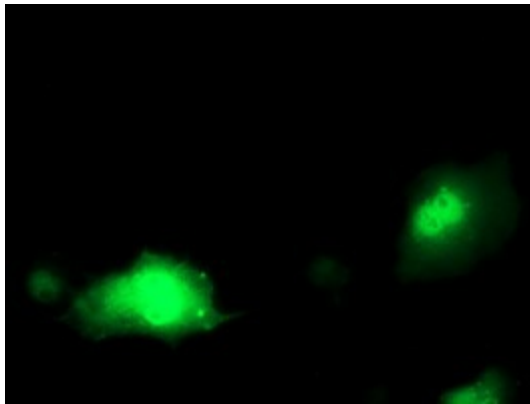

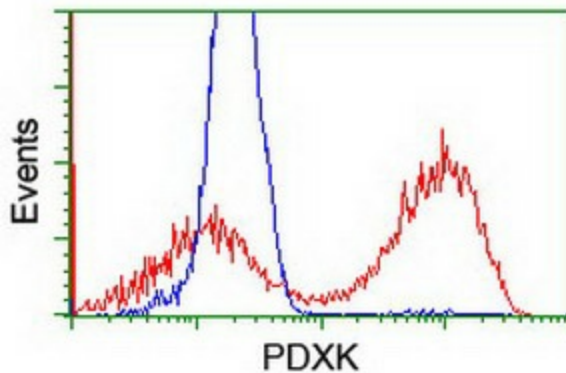
