








HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CYB5R2 (Cat# [RC217261], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CYB5R2(Cat# TA503251). Positive lysates [LY414112] (100ug) and [LC414112] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-CYB5R2 monoclonal antibody (HepG2: human; HeLa: human; SVT2: mouse; A549: human; COS7: monkey; Jurkat: human; MDCK: canine; PC12: rat; MCF7: human) (1:200).



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC217261] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-CYB5R2 antibody (TA503251), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
