Background: This gene is a classical cadherin from the cadherin superfamily. The encoded protein is a

calcium dependent cell-cell adhesion glycoprotein comprised of five extracellular cadherin repeats, a transmembrane region and a highly conserved cytoplasmic tail. The protein functions during gastrulation and is required for establishment of left-right asymmetry. At certain central nervous system synapses, presynaptic to postsynaptic adhesion is mediated at








HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CDH2 (Cat# [RC207170], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CDH2 (Cat# [TA503933]). Positive lysates [LY419743] (100ug) and [LC419743] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.




Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-CDH2 monoclonal antibody.







Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 6 cell lines by using anti-CDH2 monoclonal antibody (1:500).




Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (10 ug per lane) of wild-type 293T cells (WT, Cat# LC810293T) and CDH2-Knockout 293T cells (KO, Cat# [LC840285]) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CDH2 monoclonal antibody [TA503933], (1:500). Then the blotted membrane was stripped and reprobed with antib-actin antibody ([TA811000]) as a loading control.











