






# **Product images:**



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY SPINT1 ([RC218993], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-SPINT1. Positive lysates [LY405735] (100ug) and [LC405735] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC218993] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-SPINT1 antibody ([TA504664]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
