conjugated to other proteins. SENP2 is one of a group of enzymes that process newly synthesized SUMO1 into the conjugatable form and catalyze the deconjugation of SUMO1-






Protein Pathways: Wnt signaling pathway




HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY SENP2 ([RC208109], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-SENP2.



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffinembedded Human liver tissue within the normal limits using anti-SENP2 mouse monoclonal antibody. (Heat-induced epitope retrieval by 10mM citric buffer, pH6.0, 100°C for 10min, [TA504810])



Anti-SENP2 mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA504810]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY SENP2 ([RC208109]).



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC208109] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-SENP2 antibody ([TA504810]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
