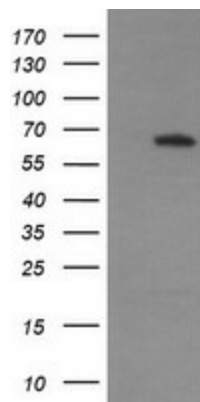

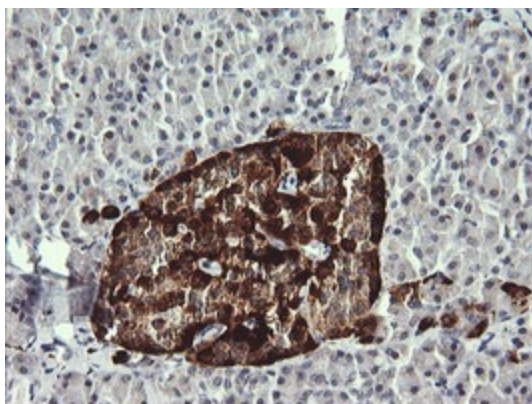

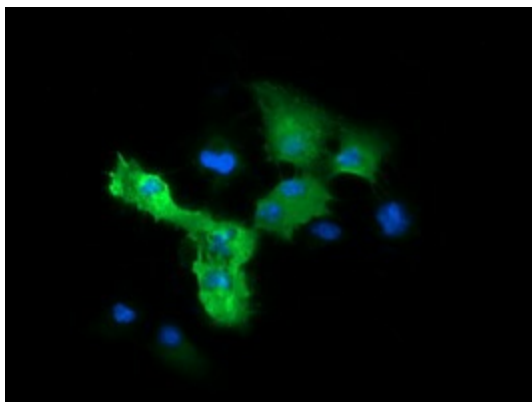

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MAPK4 ([RC207414], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MAPK4. Positive lysates [LY419131] (100ug) and [LC419131] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffin-embedded Human pancreas tissue within the normal limits using anti-MAPK4 mouse monoclonal antibody. (Heat-induced epitope retrieval by 10mM citric buffer, pH6.0, 120°C for 3min, [TA505872])
