cells. This gene contains no introns. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]

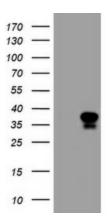

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MAFB ([RC207311], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MAFB. Positive lysates [LY401676] (100ug) and [LC401676] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
