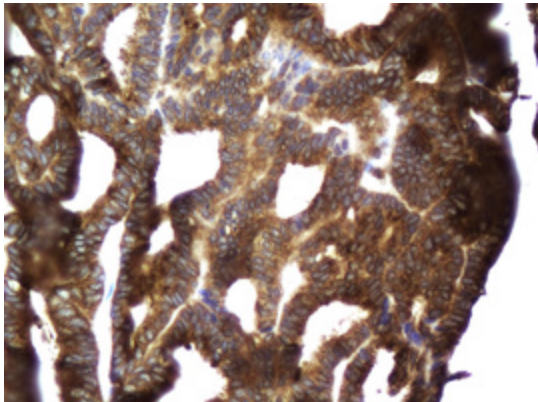

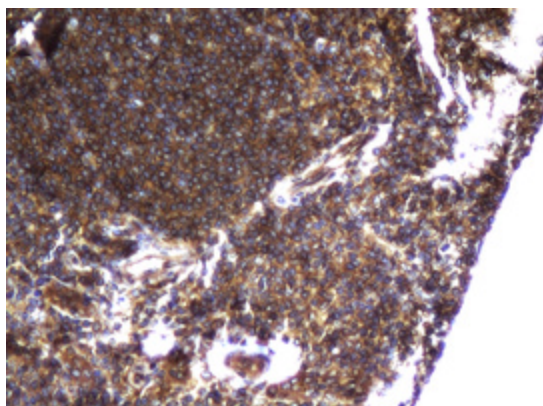
HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CCDC93 (Cat# [RC206101], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CCDC93(Cat# TA800559). Positive lysates [LY412751] (100ug) and [LC412751] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



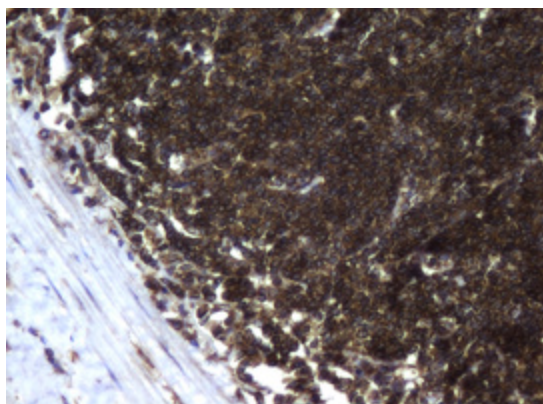
