Background: This gene encodes a protein possessing an RNA helicase motif containing a DEXH box in its

amino terminus and an RNA motif in the carboxy terminus. The encoded protein functions as a ribonuclease and is required by the RNA interference and small temporal RNA (stRNA) pathways to produce the active small RNA component that represses gene expression. 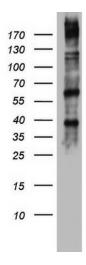




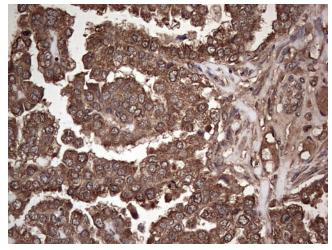

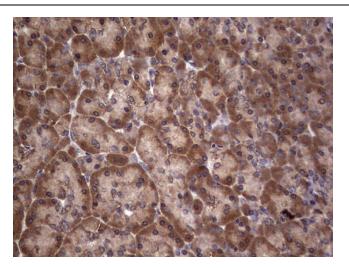


Western blot analysis of HT29 cell lysate (35ug) by using anti-DICER1 monoclonal antibody. Dilution: 1:500
