membrane proteins that interact with each other to facilitate mitochondrial targeting.










HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MFN1 ([RC207184], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MFN1. Positive lysates [LY403252] (100ug) and [LC403252] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
