**Background:** The B lymphocyte antigen receptor is a multimeric complex that includes the antigen-specific

component, surface immunoglobulin (Ig). Surface Ig non-covalently associates with two other proteins, Ig-alpha and Ig-beta, which are necessary for expression and function of the B-cell antigen receptor. This gene encodes the Ig-alpha protein of the B-cell antigen component. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been described.











HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CD79A (Cat# [RC220359], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CD79A(Cat# [TA803156]). Positive lysates [LY400674] (100ug) and [LC400674] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.




Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 5 different cell lines and human spleen tissue lysate by using anti-CD79A monoclonal antibody (1:500).







