**Background:** This gene encodes a member of the Kunitz-type serine proteinase inhibitor family. The

protein can inhibit a variety of serine proteases including factor VIIa/tissue factor, factor Xa, plasmin, trypsin, chymotryspin and plasma kallikrein. This gene has been identified as a tumor suppressor gene in several types of cancer. Alternative splicing results in multiple



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY TFPI2 ([RC202760], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-TFPI2. Positive lysates [LY416564] (100ug) and [LC416564] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
